Winter Weather Suggested Packing List

- Winter Boots w/ Liners (Not Tennis Shoes)
- Extra Liners for boots
- Socks (Wear 2 pair, bring 2 extra)
- Preferably wool or wool blend
- Long Underwear (wear 1, bring 1)
- Pants (several pairs)
- Long Sleeve Shirts, Sweaters
- Sweat Suit (for sleeping in)
- Winter Jacket
- Hooded Sweat Shirt
- Gloves or Mittens (2 pairs or more if they are not waterproof)
- Stocking Caps (2)
- Snow Pants
- Knife, Fork, Spoon
- Bowl (we will supply plates)
- Insulated Cup
- Flashlight w/ extra batteries
- Winter Sleeping Bag or Sleeping Bag w/ extra Blanket
- Insulating Pad for under sleeping bag
- Toothbrush/Paste
- Small amount of Candy for snacks

THINGS TO LEAVE AT HOME

Radios, Portable Video Games, Large knives, Large amounts of cash, Tennis Shoes

We will provide all food for meals as well as the paper plates, cooking equipment, serving utensils.

We are in a cabin but it is not heated above 60 degrees at night. Bring extra clothes as clothes tend to get wet playing in the snow. Pack supplies in a plastic bin (purchase at Target or Kmart). Everything should be packed in one bin except sleeping bag and pad. Winter sleeping bags are available for check out from the troop but advance notice must be given to Mike in order to reserve one.

It is VERY important to dress in layers. Layered clothing is the most efficient for keeping warm
